Proceedings of 24th General Body Meeting

24th Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of the Agricultural Economics Research Association (India) was held on 17th December 2016 at 12.30 AM at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar, Uttar Pradesh.

Dr. P G Chengappa, President of the Association, chaired the meeting and welcomed the members present at the AGM.

Before taking up the Agenda for discussion, the house was informed about the sad and sudden demise of Dr P C Bansil and Dr. J P Dhaka. The members paid rich tributes to them for their contribution to AERA and the profession. The members observed two minute silence and prayed to the Almighty for giving peace to the departed souls.

The house was reconvened and the agenda items listed below were taken up for discussion.

Agenda item 1: To approve the minutes of the previous Annual General Body Meeting held on 4th December 2015 at Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai

The minutes of the 23rd Annual General Body meeting held on 4th December 2015 at Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai (Maharashtra) were read and confirmed by the GB without any amendments.

Agenda item 2: To approve the Annual Report of AERA for the year 2015-16.

Dr. Suresh Pal, Secretary of the Association, presented the Annual Report for the financial year ending 2015-16. Regarding the membership of AERA, Dr Pal informed that it stood at 1098 comprising of 850 life members, 108 ordinary members, 115 institutional members and 25 honorary life members.

Regarding publication of the Journal, the Secretary informed that Jan-June 2016 Issue was despatched in May 2016 and July-Dec 2016 will be ready by December 2016. There is no backlog of papers received for publication. Regarding conference issue, he informed that there was a tremendous response from the authors and a record number of 118 papers were received for discussion at this Conference. For selection of full-length papers for this issue, a Review Committee of Dr Mruthyunjaya, Dr PG Chengappa, Dr NP Singh and the Conference President Dr Praduman Kumar was constituted and the members were provided articles without the names and affiliations of authors for a fair evaluation. Based on the recommendations of this Review Committee and consent of Dr P Kumar, Conference President, 16 papers have been published as full length papers and the rest were published in abstract form.

The Secretary informed that full articles of AERR journal both of regular issues and conference number are being uploaded at the 'AgEcon search' which is a free, open access repository of full-text scholarly literature in agricultural and applied economics. It is managed by the University of Minnesota, USA and is linked to other international libraries. This has increased access to the journal and there has been significant increase in the citations. Online processing of journal articles has been started and distribution is being made through IndianJournals.com

The Secretary informed the house that all required information about AERR was submitted to NAAS for revision of the rating. The members expressed satisfaction about increase in downloads and citations of articles published in AERR. The number of articles submitted for publication in the journal is also rising fast.

The Association in partnership with ISAE and other organizations shall organize conference of IAAE in 2021. The conference will be held in NASC complex Delhi.

The Secretary thanked the Executive Committee, Editorial Board and all the members. He expressed gratefulness to all the learned referees who gave their valuable time in going through the articles submitted to AERR for publication and Dr BS Aggarwal for language editing of the journal.

The members applauded the work carried out by the AERA and approved the Report unanimously.

Agenda item 3: To approve the audited account statement and Treasurer's Report of AERA for the year 2015-16.

Dr. Anjani Kumar, Treasurer of the Association, presented the Audit Report of the Association for the year ending 31 March 2016. It was informed that the Association incurred an expenditure of Rs 22.70 lakh against a revenue of Rs 24.72 lakh in 2015-16. The reserve fund stands at Rs 29.80 lakh by the end of March 2016. The need to improve the revenue in the light of escalating costs was highlighted by the Treasurer. The members unanimously approved the report.

Agenda item 4: To approve the auditor for AERA for the financial year 2016-17. The GB resolved to appoint M/s S Sukhija & Associates as auditors for auditing of the accounts of AERA for the financial year 2016-17.

Agenda item 5: To approve Dr. R T Doshi Foundation Awards for 2015.

Dr. R. T. Doshi Foundation, Mumbai, has instituted two awards for the best research articles published in *Agricultural Economics Research Review* and for two best paper presentations made during the AERA Conference. The prize money was revised since 2014 and the first prize for the best articles stands now at Rs 10,000/- and the second prize at Rs 5,000/- Similarly, first and second prizes for the conference presentations are Rs 10,000/- and Rs 5,000/- respectively. On the recommendations of the Committee under the chairmanship of Dr SS Acharya, the guidelines were formulated and implemented since 2014. The members thanked the Chairman and trustees of the Dr. R. T. Doshi Foundation for their continued support. The President distributed the certificates and prize money for the 2015 winners.

The President constituted a committee of Dr S.S Acharya and Dr M. Krishnan for evaluation of the articles published in *Agricultural Economics Research Review*, Volume 28 (2015) and the winners are as follows:
